1. Highlights of *significant* actions taken since your last report:

Other comments or concerns to be discussed at the Executive Board meeting (not automatic motions): Section 5: Membership

a. Associate Membership Policy (Local Chapter Limitation)

Associate memberships shall only reside at the local chapter level. The dues rate shall be determined by the local. No benefits shall reside from the state or national for associate members. Associate membership cannot be granted to anyone who qualifies for full membership in NCRSP.

b. Worked with Mrs. Joan Bass, NCRSP Policies Chair on:

1. Section 7: Reimbursement of Expenses Policy
2. Section 8: NEA-Retired Delegates

c. NCRSP IRS/ NC Incorporation issues with NCRSP Constitution and Bylaws. Worked with Carmen Brewington-Code, Chair of NCRSP Constitution and Bylaws .

Made editorial changes in both documents to comply with the IRS requirement that NCRSP become a nonprofit NC based corporation to enable the state organization to file the needed IRS papers to have oversight of the finances and tax reporting capacity for our districts and locals across the state of North Carolina.

d. NCAE Resolution Committee : At the most recent meeting of this committee sought to add a new resolution which mentioned both retired and NCRSP as a part of the NEA, NCAE family of organizations.
